I am writing to inform you that your child will be undertaking assessments in their lessons as part of the year 10 assessment week, which will take place w/c 13th November. In order to help prepare for these assessments I have put together a summary of information to support parents/carers and students at home.

This will be the first year group assessment for year 10 and will help establish where the students are during the beginning period of year 10. The assessments will help us monitor their progress and will help in establishing routines of revision for our students.
