
New behaviour system - ATLs and rewards

Attendance matters




If students are not in school they will not get the ATL points for that day

| None | 100% | 0 | 0 | 0 |
| Low | 97% | 6 | 1 | 36 |
| Medium | 95% | 9.5 | 2 | 57 |
| High | 90% | 19 | 4 | 114 |
| High | 85% | 28.5 | 6 | 171 |
| High | 80% | 38 | 8 | 228 |

Half as many students with an attendance of less than 90% achieve grades 4-9 in English/maths than students with 95%+




How can you help your child at home?

Correlation between reading ability and GCSE results








Year 9

Guided Choices




Year 9 students will make some important decisions this academic year.



- Progress to Silver and Gold awards.


Flamingo Land

- Attendance will be based off Arbor scores




Director of Studies Report

- Great preparation for assessments and future years.




Careers
